He married first Rotrude, daughter of Louis the Pious. They had the following children:

- Ranulf I of Poitiers, Duke of Aquitaine (815-866)
- Gerhard II, Count of Limousin (-879)
- Unknown daughter

He then married her sister Hildegard, they had no children.

- 3 children of Ranulf I of Poitiers, including Ranulf II of Poitiers

Great-grandchildren

- 1 grandson of Ranulf I of Poitiers, Ebalus of Aquitaine
