Form E.—Question No. 12 will only be asked in cases where an abbreviated answer has been given relative to question 10 or to question 11.  
Form F.—Question No. 14 will only be asked in cases where a partial occupation has been reported in column 13.  
Form G.—Question 7 on abbreviations in the name of the month may be used, as Jan., Apr., Dec.
