

# Regnar II, Count of Hainaut

**Regnar II** (890–932) was **Count of Hainaut** (also written **Rainier II, Count of Hainault**<sup>[1]</sup>) from 915 until 932.

## History

He was the son of Regnar, Duke of Lorraine and Hersent of France. His mother possibly was a daughter of Charles the Bald and Ermentrude.

## Family

Regnar II married Adelaide of Burgundy, daughter of Richard, Duke of Burgundy and Adelaide of Auxerre, with whom he fathered Regnar III, Count of Hainaut.
